

## **Columbia University/The Clearing House Conference: “Optimal Bank Liquidity Regulation” Call for Papers**

Call for Papers Deadline: November 1, 2017

Conference date and location: February 9, 2018; New York, NY

The Clearing House Association and Columbia University's School of International and Public Affairs invite the submission of papers for a conference on “Optimal Bank Liquidity Regulation,” which will be held on February 9, 2018 at Columbia University. The purpose of the conference is to bring together academics, market participants, and policymakers to discuss the latest research on liquidity regulation, its impact on financial markets, financial stability and monetary policy.

TOPICS: We invite the submission of papers that explore all aspects of bank liquidity regulation, including, but not limited to:

- The optimal level of bank liquidity for financial stability.
- The costs and benefits of higher liquidity requirements with respect to macroeconomic outcomes, credit availability or firm performance.
- The liquidity necessary for bank resolution and recovery.
- Interaction between liquidity requirements and capital requirements.
- The implications of liquidity requirements for central bank monetary policy operating frameworks and the implications of monetary policy frameworks for liquidity requirements.
- The relationship between liquidity requirements and the neutral level of short-term interest rates.
- The use of liquid assets during periods of stress and the interaction of liquidity requirements and lender of last resort.

We welcome theoretical, empirical and policy-oriented papers, particularly those focused on post-financial crisis developments.

PAPER SUBMISSION PROCEDURE: The deadline to submit a detailed abstract or completed paper is November 1, 2017. Please send your submissions by email to [sipa\\_conf@columbia.edu](mailto:sipa_conf@columbia.edu).

Authors of accepted papers will be notified by December 15, 2017. Travel and accommodation expenses will be covered for one presenter of each accepted paper.
